You've been waiting eight months and the time is finally here to join us VIRTUALLY to learn about the 2019 ASHE Lake Erie Project of the Year Award winners.

Over \$10M: Towpath Trail, Stage 3, Cuyahoga County Department of Public Works - Darwin Merdes, PE, CCDPW, and Doug Blank, PE, Michael Baker International, will present on this recently completed stage of the Towpath Trail in the industrial flats of Cleveland and Tremont neighborhood of Cleveland. This trail segment provides safe and efficient links to downtown for commuters, enabling cleaner pedestrian and bicycle traffic.

Under \$10M: Pearl Road (US-42) Rehabilitation, City of Cleveland – Chris Preto, PE, of Mott McDonald, will present on the rehabilitation of this three-mile long project between Brookpark Road and I-71, a highly travelled corridor with numerous civic institutions and connections to several neighborhoods, GCRTA routes and the Cleveland Zoo. The scope of work on this project was based on a NOACA TLCI report and included numerous design challenges which will be discussed.
