EVENT: Project of the Year

Join us to hear from Jackie Guttman, PE of The Ruhlin Company and Jonathan Hren, PE of ms consultants for a presentation on the design and construction of the LAK-271-01.27/01.45 project for ODOT District 12. This project is the replacement of Ramp C which carries traffic from NB I-271 to WB I-90 in Willoughby Hills, Ohio. The 2-lane high speed ramp was reconstructed on the inside of the former alignment and features two new structures, a 3-span rolled beam bridge over Eddy Road and a 4-span curved plate girder bridge over I-271. This presentation will focus on the project background, including scope modification and funding, design, and construction including MOT, embankment and substructure construction, and bridge construction challenges over a busy interstate segment.
