2022 OUTSTANDING TRANSPORTATION PROJECT AWARD

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

I. Categories

- a. Construction cost less than \$10,000,000
- b. Construction cost greater than \$10,000,000

II. General Criteria

- a. Entries must be sponsored by a project participant (Owner, Designer or Contractor) who is a member in good standing of ASHE Lake Erie Section.
- b. Applicants can submit more than one entry.
- c. Project shall be directly related to one or more of the following areas in the field of transportation:
 - i. Highways/Roads
 - ii. Bridges
 - iii. Signalization and Traffic Related
 - iv. Railroads
 - v. Public Transit
 - vi. Bikeways
- d. Project must be located within the following counties:
 - i. Cuyahoga
 - ii. Lake
 - iii. Geauga
 - iv. Lorain
 - v. Ashtabula
- e. Project must be substantially completed between January 1, 2021 and December 31, 2022.
- f. Entries must conform to Entry Requirements.
- g. ASHE Lake Erie Section will not be responsible for any damage or loss to entrant's entry materials and reserves the right to use materials for promotional purposes such as display at meetings, on the ASHE website and at trade shows.
- h. ASHE Lake Erie Section Award Committee reserves the right to determine the eligibility of all entries.

III. Entry Requirements

- a. One PDF of the submittal (entry form and associated narrative, photos, etc.) shall be provided
- b. Entries must be received on or before January 23, 2023.
- c. The sponsoring member verifying that the project was substantially completed between January 1, 2021 and December 31, 2022 and shall sign entry form.

- d. A narrative of the project not exceeding 750 words or one side of one page (8½"x11"). The narrative shall include a discussion on how the project meets the judging criteria. Project design and construction costs shall be provided.
- e. No less than three (3) or more than five (5) relative construction drawings on 8 ½"x11" pages.
- f. No less than three (3) or more than five (5) photos (maximum size: 8½"x11")
- g. Entry fee of \$150.00 for each project submitted. Make checks payable to ASHE Lake Erie Section.

IV. Award

- a. Awards will be provided in two categories:
 - i. Construction costs up to \$10,000,000
 - ii. Construction costs exceeding \$10,000,000
- b. Awards will be presented to one representative each owner, designer and prime contractor.
- c. Three matching awards with the name of project will be provided by ASHE Lake Erie Section to the owner, designer and contractor. Any additional awards desired (exceeding the three provided) by the winning project team can be purchased from the ASHE Lake Erie Section for an additional fee.
- d. Free meal for 1 representative from owner, designer, and contractor at awards meeting.
- e. Winning entries will be invited to make a presentation of their project at the awards meeting.
- f. Announcement of award and profile of the project will be published on ASHE Lake Erie Section website.
- g. Winning entries will be eligible for the ASHE Great Lakes Region Project of the Year Award. Entry fees will be paid for by ASHE Lake Erie Section.
- h. The over \$10M winning entry will be required to author a 500-1,000 word article for publication in the ASHE Scanner magazine. The article will be due within 30 days following the receipt of the award. The under \$10M winning entry will only submit an article if there is no over \$10M winning entry.

V. Judging

- a. Entries will be judged on the following subcategories:
 - i. Importance to the traveling public
 - ii. Complexity
 - iii. Innovation and unique features
 - iv. Aesthetics and sustainable features
- b. Each subcategory will be rated from 0 to 25 with 25 being the best score.
- c. The winner will be determined based on the total combined number of points from all judges.
- d. The judging panel reserves the right not to award for a construction dollar category if the highest score does not exceed 70.
- e. The judging panel will be comprised of five (5) members of the Lake Erie Section not associated with the project.
