EVENT: 2022 ASHE Lake Erie Outstanding Transportation Project of the Year Awards

Over \$10M: Opportunity Corridor Section 3, ODOT, District 12 – Julie Meyer, Kerry Hart, and Sean Milroy will present on the Opportunity Corridor, a new 3-mile roadway that runs from East 55th St at Interstate 490 to East 105th St, which brings enhanced transportation, mobility and connectivity to this area, and is spurring new economic development, new jobs and a new identity for the historically underserved community. Section 3 installed 2 miles of the new five-lane boulevard on a new alignment, including seven signalized intersections.

Under \$10M: Red Line Greenway, Cleveland Metroparks – Sean McDermott and Doug Blank will present on the Red Line Greenway, one of five trails built as part of the Re-Connecting Cleveland: TIGER Trails program, managed and maintained by Cleveland Metroparks. Red Line Greenway connects the Zone Rec Center at West 65th Street to the west bank of the Cuyahoga River and the larger network of multimodal trails in Cleveland through a combination of ODOT, City of Cleveland, and GCRTA right-of-way and a wide range of urban terrain.
